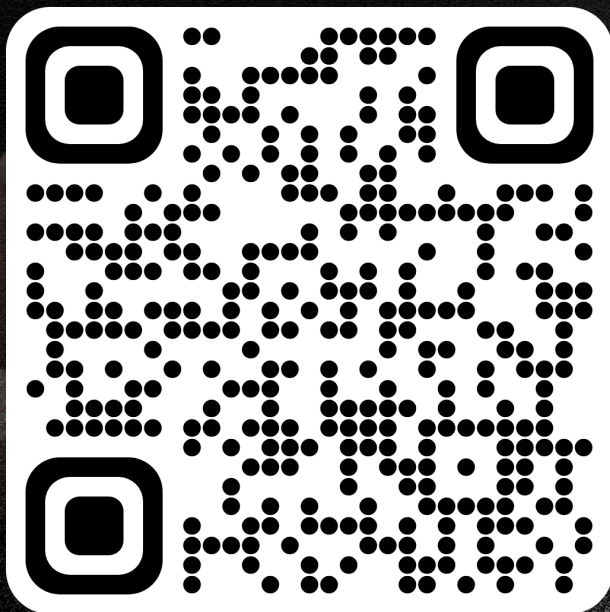

Eric's background as a player, as a collegiate coach, club director, and current commissioner of the Lakeshore Region of USA Volleyball brings an extremely unique and robust skill to all the students he works with at the club and the MCC Volleyball program.

His lifelong passion for the game of volleyball began while in college first at Central Michigan then at Michigan State and has continued throughout adulthood, as he transitioned from collegiate player, to professional beach player, to professionally trained coach.

## HIGHLIGHTS:

- Nye finished with 14 kills on 21 attempts. She added four total blocks.
- **Skylar Cramer** continued her strong play at the setter position with 48 assists, 11 digs, and three service aces.
- **Ruby Earl** recorded 12 kills, 11 digs, and three aces, while **Princess Savage** added 10 kills.
- **Chloe Vanwinkle** finished with nine kills and nine digs.
- **Montgomery Rotter** had a team-high 13 digs, while **Chloe Wright** and **Brooklynn Wilcox** added 11 and nine, respectively.
- The Bears combined for a .201 hitting percentage.

**WARREN, Mich.** - The Mott Community College volleyball team opened the MCCAAschedule with a four-set win on the road over Macomb Community College on Monday.

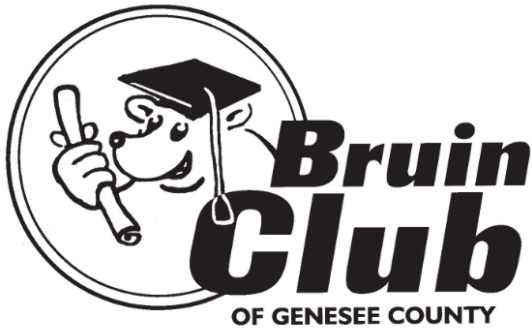
The Bears were led by the offense of Courtney Nye, who finished with a .571 hitting percentage. After dropping the opening set, Mott won three straight and cruised in the final set for a 22-25, 25-23, 25-22, 25-12 victory. The win moves Mott to 8-4 overall and 1-0 in the MCCAAschedule.
